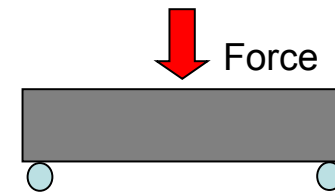
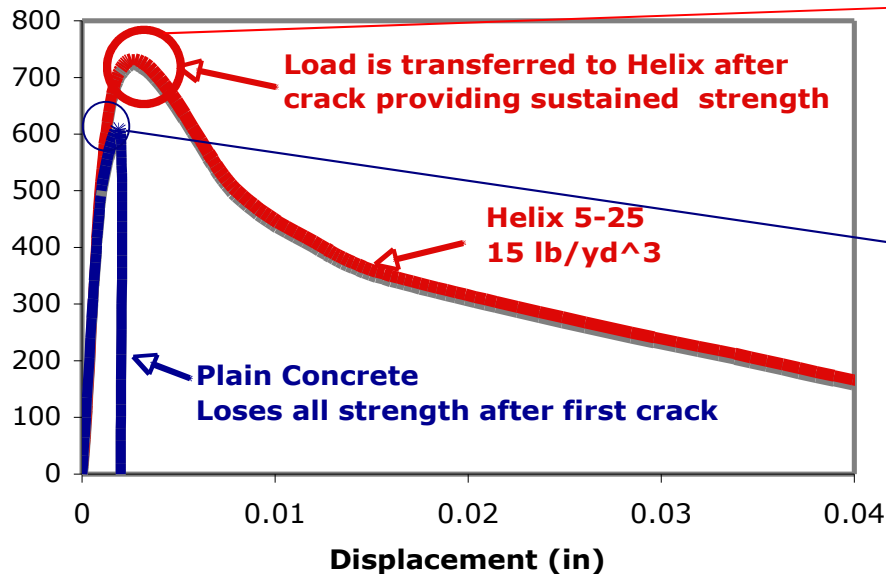


Helix vs. Plain Concrete

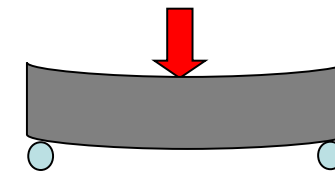
Once plain concrete cracks, it has no strength.

Helix gives concrete strength to resist cracking and then holds those cracks that do form to nearly invisible (Class I) hairlines.
